A Local Arts Agency (LAA) is a community local arts organization that provides financial support, services, or other programs for a variety of arts activities and/or individual artists within the community as a whole and has a permanent administrative facility, a representative board, and at least a part-time Executive/Artistic Director.

A Major Arts Partner (MAP) is an arts organization with an operating budget of \$1 million or greater.
